

Note on the 3rd Eurolinguistics Conference at Europäisches Haus Pappenheim

The Europäisches Haus Pappenheim (EHP) would like to invite you to our house's 3rd Eurolinguistics Conference, planned for 10-12 April 2015 at the small town of Pappenheim in the enchanting Altmühl valley. Based on last conference's discussions, the frame topic for the next conference will be

Building Eurolinguistics as a Solid Subject.

The conference is open to basic research, applied research and interdisciplinary research. Papers should cover topics that, in the speaker's view, should be considered obligatory elements in a solid Eurolinguistic curriculum (at university as well as potentially at school). Again, we also plan to publish the conference papers. In addition to this, we plan to compose, on the last day of the conference, a memorandum aiming to establish Eurolinguistics as a constant subject at universities and schools. The final version of the memorandum will be sent to national and international politicians.

Due to the positive experiences at the 2013 and 2014 conferences, there shall again be a section in which experts and laypersons discuss with each other (this time we will reserve Saturday early evening for this). It is the EHP's aim that not only the academic, but also the general public becomes more aware of Eurolinguistic work. The topics for the public discussion shall be taken from the papers presented at the "conference proper".

Everyone is warmly invited to suggest a paper for the conference. Each topic should be **truly Eurolinguistic** in the sense that it approaches or gives examples from all major language groups (Romance, Germanic, Slavic, Finno-Ugric) and all geo-cultural areas (north, west, south, east [with or without Russia]). It seems appropriate to declare those European languages with the largest numbers of speakers our conference languages (English, German, French, Italian, Polish, Russian). However, the largest number of colleagues will probably be reached when the talk is given in English.

Colleagues from different countries have already confirmed their active participation, but there are still some time-slots left. Please send your proposals as soon as possible to grzega@pappenheim.de or ehp@pappenheim.de.
